WESSEX ARCHAEOLOGY HERITAGE STATEMENT

Our conclusions to this documents are as follows:

On the parts of the development site not deemed of Special Interest no Enclosure Ditches were identified (Ref 7.3.2) which means there is more work needed to be carried out to fully characterise the area leading to possibly finding more archaeological evidence of settlements. This area extends to the area of Ancient Woodland as explained in Ref 7.3.2.

10.6 It would seem in summing up that Wessex archaeology felt that any development would have significant impact on any archaeological remains.

It is our conclusion that a more thorough Archaeological Survey needs to be undertaken to determine the true extent of the archaeology on the whole site before development destroys what is possibly lying undiscovered.
